



Valve Body Unit Overhaul -

Removal:

- 1. Drain the power steering fluid (page 11-27).
- 2. Remove the gearbox shield.
- Using solvent and a brush, wash any oil and dirt off the control unit, its lines, and that end of the gearbox, Blow dry with compressed air.




- Using flare nut wrenches, disconnect the four lines from the control unit.
 - A: From pump: 14 mm wrench 38 N·m (3.8 kg-m, 28 lb-ft)
 B: To reservoir: 12 mm wrench 13 N·m (1.3 kg-m, 9 lb-ft)
 C: To eil cooler: 17 mm wrench
 - C: To oil cooler: 17 mm wrench 29 N·m (2.9 kg-m, 20 lb-ft)




Disassembly:

- Remove the two 6 mm flange bolts and remove the control unit from the gearbox.
- Remove the O-rings and port orifices from the gearbox.
- 7. Remove the O-rings from the control unit.



- Remove the two 6 mm flange bolts, and remove the cap from the valve body.
- 9. Remove the port seal from the cap.
