
## Intermediate Shaft

## - Replacement -


- 1. Drain oil from the transmission.
- 2. Remove the three 10 mm bolts.

10 x 1.25 mm 39 N·m (3.9 kg·m, 28 lb·ft)



Lower the bearing support close to the steering gearbox and remove the intermediate shaft from the differential.


CAUTION: To prevent damage to the differential oil seal, hold the intermediate shaft horizontal until it is clear of the differential.



Installation is the reverse order of removal.

## Disassembly

- 1. Remove the intermediate shaft outer seal.
- 2. Remove the external circlip.



 Remove the intermediate shaft.
NOTE: The shaft can be hammered out using the driver and pilot, it the bearing support is clamped in a softjawed vise.
