



Hub Unit Bearing Replacement -

- Jack up the rear of car and support on safety stands in proper location.
- 2. Remove the rear wheel, two 6 mm screws and brake
 - NOTE: If the brake disc is difficult to remove, install 8 mm bolts into the threaded and tighten them.
- 3. Remove the hub unit cap unstake the spindle nut, then loosen the spindle nut.
- 4. Remove the hub unit and hub unit bearing.



- Damper Removal -

- Jack up the rear of car and support on safety stands in proper locations.
- 2. Remove the damper upper cover at the rear seat lining.
- 3. Remove the damper upper mounting base nuts.



- 4. Remove the damper mounting bolt.
- Lower the lower arms and remove the damper assembly.
